At the core of FortiPost's superior performance is the use of slow-grown, machine rounded Pine, chosen for its high sapwood content, which enables maximum preservative uptake during treatment. This ensures unrivalled penetration of preservative deep into the vulnerable sapwood, resulting in exceptional protection against fungal rot and decay.

FortiPost is treated here in the UK, with full control over the conditioning and pressure treatment process and by an approved Benchmark treater. Timbers are dried to 25% and below, through state of the art drying kilns. The result is absolute quality assurance; correctly conditioned timbers, treated with our unique formulation of preservative and applied using our bespoke 40-year pressure treatment cycle, make FortiPost the only trusted and responsible choice for long life fencing.

Another standout feature of FortiPost is its innovative four-way engineered point, designed specifically to establish superior ground anchoring for both straining posts and stakes. This precision-cut point allows for cleaner, easier installation while improving the post's stability in the ground — a critical factor in maintaining fence line integrity over time. Whether in soft soils or more challenging terrain, this engineered point ensures a solid foundation with anti-twist attributes that installers can trust.

As the agricultural industry continues to look for alternatives to creosote-based treatments due
